### The Sorrowful Mysteries

- **1. The Agony in the Garden.** Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane on the night before he dies.
- **1. The Scourging at the Pillar.** Jesus is lashed with whips.
- **1. The Crowning With Thorns.** Jesus is mocked and crowned with thorns.
- **1. The Carrying of the Cross.** Jesus carries the cross that will be used to crucify him.
- **1. The Crucifixion.** Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies.





- **4. The Transfiguration of Jesus.** Jesus is revealed in glory to Peter, James, and John.
- **5. The Institution of the Eucharist.** Jesus offers his Body and Blood at the Last Supper.




