With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.


We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.

Through our participation in this Synodal journey, May we learn to balance between uniting in shared experiences, And appreciating the distinctions of each person's life and circumstances.


In the paradox of the Trinity, The more we come to understand the uniqueness of each of the three Persons, The more we feel the unity that exists within.

Discernment


Good and loving God, our source of love and light, Thank you for bringing us together today In a spirit of generosity.

May Thy will be done, through us and in us as we take our rightful part in our journey of faith.






Mission
